## **Abstract:**

The aim of the EATRIS-TRI.si is to establish a state-of-the-art infrastructure for translational research in the field of pharmacy and biomedicine, and to encourage innovations that seek new entrepreneurial opportunities in the field of drug development and drug repurposing. The principle of translational research is to ensure that new findings come into practice as quickly as possible, either in the process of drug development, diagnostic approaches, or to the patients. The concept of EATRIS-TRI.si reflects the mission of the multicentric research infrastructure of the umbrella organization EATRIS ERIC, which predicts the establishment of a node in the partner member states. Correspondingly, EATRIS-TRI.si pursues institutional and regional representation within Slovenia, which enables networking, cooperation, and faster and higher quality research. The project has the status of an implemented ESFRI project and thus ranks as a national priority field for the development of research infrastructure, and its goal is to increase the international competitiveness of Slovenian infrastructure for research and development.
