- 2. The pedagogical process

 - Lectures and seminars are not held, but handouts and study materials are provided to students for self-study
- Mandatory laboratory practical course will be organized
- Please contact professors, student's office via e-communication
- 3. Hygiene measures
 - Different disinfectants are placed at entrances to lecture halls, please use in accordance with the instructions for hand disinfection.
 - We disconnected the electric hand dryers and temporarily introduced paper towels on the toilets.
- 4. Holding in self-isolation
- All of you who have stayed in the last 10 days in Italian places: Casalpusterlengo, Codogno, Castiglione d'Adda, Fombio, Maleo, Somaglia, Bertonico, Terranova dei Passerini, Castelgerundo, San Fiorano and around Vo 'Euganeo in the province of Padua, or have travelled outside Europe where a coronavirus epidemic has occurred please stay at home for the next 14 days, regardless of your wellbeing. Inform your supervisor about this, who will properly record your absence.
- If you have any signs of coronavirus infection (fever, cough, shortness of breath, shortness of breath) inform your doctor by phone or email. Do not go to the infirmary unannounced to avoid infecting others. The health service is informed of, and well prepared for, suspected coronavirus infection. If you do not get sick in 14 days, you can return to work.
